

Conditions of Hire

This document forms our Conditions of Hire.

All equipment to be used strictly in accordance with these conditions to ensure safe practice at all times.

By confirming your instructions to Us or paying our Invoice, you agree that you have read and agree to abide by these conditions. You will be held liable for any damage incurred, or any injury to persons or property as a result of these instructions not being abided by.

Instructions for use

Gazebos:

- Gazebos are to be erected by Our staff upon Delivery, except in exceptional and previously agreed circumstances.
- Weights will be supplied by Us and should be used at all times on all feet of supplied gazebos. Please note that the gazebo weights are extremely heavy and can cause damage to property and persons if not handled correctly. Please follow manufacturer's instructions.
- In the event of high winds being forecast:
 - a) If 25mph+ winds are experienced or are forecast by BBC weather, You agree to drop the height of any gazebos hired to the lowest level.
 - b) If 35mph+ winds are experienced or are forecast by BBC weather, You agree to completely dismantle any gazebos hired.
- In the event of any damage to either the gazebos themselves, or damage or injury to people or property caused by any gazebo still erected in such conditions, We will not be held liable.
- Under no circumstances should heaters or gas appliances (e.g. patio heaters, barbecues, stand-alone portable calor gas heaters), apart from those supplied by Party Fun Hire, be used inside the gazebos. We cannot be held liable for any damage or injury as a result of use of other appliances.

Gazebo Heaters:

- Heaters should only be set up above a table for safety reasons.
- Heaters come with a remote control which must be returned before deposit can be refunded
- WARNING: Heaters become hot when in use. Please do not touch and keep away from children or animals.
- No heaters apart from those supplied by Party Fun Hire should be used with our gazebos.

Tables:

- All tables come with safety clips or poles to provide added strength once erected. These are to be locked in place before use.
- Tables should be used solely for the purpose for which they are designed.
- At no time and under no circumstances should any person, children included, stand, sit or dance on any table hired from Us.

Chairs:

- Our chairs are designed to snap into place when setting up. Please ensure that these are fully locked into place before use to avoid collapse, damage or injury.

Chair Covers:

- No items should be pinned, stuck or stapled to chair covers. Any damage incurred by such action will result in the hirer being charged for replacement covers.

Oak Dance Floor

- The dance floor should be set up on a completely flat surface and in weather proof conditions.
- The floor can be set up in external buildings or in a marquee, but only on solid ground; it cannot be set up on grass.
- Once set up, You must not move or dismantle the floor, unless otherwise arranged.
- The floor must not be washed, mopped or polished.
- Any spillages should be soaked up with an absorbent cloth to remove excess fluid.

Garden Games:

- Our garden games are suitable for outdoor as well as indoor use, but only in completely dry conditions.
- They are not suitable for use in wet weather and must be completely protected from rain even when not in use. They must not be left outside overnight.
- Please check components match the details attached on delivery. Deposits will only be refunded when returned in full working order and with all components.

Lights

- Lights must be secured to gazebos using cable ties.
- The plug and socket should be fully protected from water and out of reach of children.
- The electric leads should be cable tied to a solid construction.

Extension Leads

- Extension leads MUST BE fully unravelled for use (these get hot very quickly if left stored on the spool).

Cable Covers

- Cable covers (supplied free of charge with Our extension leads) must be used to cover all electric cables laid on the ground where there will be footfall.
